- 3. A motion was made by Mr. Wise and seconded by Mr. Shober to ratify the Right of Entry Agreement with Scott Hoge for 16 Gretna Road for the cleaning and reestablishment of a drainage swale. All Supervisors voted yes. The motion carried 3-0.
- 4. A motion was made by Mr. Wise and seconded by Mr. Shober to authorize payment of invoices indicated on the enclosed listing. Invoices to be paid are posted on the bulletin board for review.
